

Wood mouse

Wood mice (also known as long-tailed field mice) are very common British mammals. They are not often seen by noisy humans because they are generally nocturnal and are also very timid. A full-grown adult is approximately 95mm long. They have sandy-brown fur and their underparts are white. Wood mice only live for about 2 years. They are omnivores-eating fruits, seeds, berries, caterpillars, centipedes and fungi.
