OVERVIEW

This course is open to all abilities. Teaching and support will be tailored to each individual's capabilities to create a mixed media portrait on A3 paper. Extra material, tasks and resources will be available and you will have the opportunity to dive as deep as you want.

In this course you will learn how to combine several traditional techniques around an imaginative representation of a portrait and other related elements which, along with your subject, will create a unique artwork. Pencil drawing, watercolour, marker and collage are some of the techniques that you will explore and practise in this project and a mood-board will help you to collate your ideas for the final composition.

(Do not worry, this is not a drawing competition and drawing skills are not essential. I will guide you through the way to achieve great results!)

At the end of the course there will be the opportunity to display your best artworks in a collective art exhibition at Reveley Lodge.
